

# PROJECT PROFILE

PROJECT TYPE: PUBLIC

#### SUMMARY

This project would continue the improved streetscaping beautification from its current termination point in the middle of downtown to the actual limits of the downtown on South Washington Street by the addition of new curbing, a decorative furniture area of stamped concrete, new sidewalks, decorative light posts, and new traffic signal poles and signals.

### **COMMUNITY NEED**

This project would improve the safety and accessibility of the south end of downtown as well as make it a more inviting area for businesses and residents and encourage further redevelopment on the south end.

### TIMELINE

- Project will move forward contingent on:
  - Obtaining complete funding
  - Capacity of the City Engineer's office to manage project
  - Coordination with other City infrastructure projects
- Project timeline:
